

*Application for the Classical Association of New England's
Endowment Scholarship*

The CANE Endowment Scholarship is an award of up to \$5100 for summer study normally at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens or at places other than the American Academy in Rome.

Eligibility and Requirements

- 1. All applicants must have been members of CANE in good standing for at least two full and consecutive years immediately prior to the year in which they apply for the award.*
- 2. Priority will be given to applications from Latin teachers of secondary school, public or private, who teach within the geographical boundaries of CANE.*
- 3. It is understood that applicants will not be applying for the Endowment Scholarship and the Coulter Rome Scholarship in the same year.*
- 4. Scholarship recipients are requested to file a written report with the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee at the end of their study period.*
