Preference will be given to students applying for the remission of education course credits, but any program leading to certification will be considered.

- 1 **Two letters of recommendation from current colleagues:** if a student, professors who can speak to the quality of your language ability and/or scholarship; if a teacher, supervisor(s) and/or colleagues who can speak to your work in the classroom. Whether currently a student or a teacher, at least one recommendation should speak to your ability to communicate and work with young people, and your commitment to teaching.
- 2 **A personal statement** of no more than 1000 words that explains your reasons for pursuing a career as a pre-collegiate classicist and your goals and aspirations as a teacher.
- 3 **College transcripts.**
- 4 **Resume** detailing education and relevant work / travel experience.
- 5 **Program Description and Budget** that details institution, course name(s) (and description if not evident from name) and tuition to be reimbursed by the scholarship.
